In a culture where alarming numbers of urban youth are giving up on school, succumbing to gang pressures, making unhealthy choices about sex, and resorting to bullying and gun violence, the P22 Youth Foundation is reaching out to equip teenagers with the essentials to live victoriously.

Join P22 as we impact the lives of Greater Cleveland area teens by becoming a sponsor of our **13<sup>th</sup> Annual Teen Spiritual Camping Retreat at Mohican State Park, July 21<sup>st</sup> – July 26<sup>th</sup> 2024.** Your generous financial donation will help provide campers scholarships, which pay for facilities, food supplies and camping equipment. Above all, you will be investing in the lives of youth for eternity.

The cost for each camper is \$400.00. Our goal is to host up to 50 middle and high school youth and volunteer adult counselors for the week. Realizing that many of the campers are from underserved communities, we want to keep the camp experience free for students. **We need both financial and in-kind donations.**

Daily camp activities will include devotions, hiking, swimming and games. Campers will share in preparing meals and other group living tasks. Nightly campfire discussions will give the teens a chance to talk about what matters to them, learn how to form and strengthen relationships, grow in Christian understanding and be challenged to live out their faith.

Nearly 700 youth and Christian counselors from all over Greater Cleveland have participated in the weeklong retreat since the outing began in 2009 at no cost to the young people.

The mission of P22 is to serve as a catalyst for the spiritual development of youth through Christian-based programs.
